If you're up for a stunning walk, the Rakaia Gorge Track is a 10.4 km return along the rim of the gorge, with dramatic views of the turquoise Rakaia River and Southern Alps.

The trail passes through native forest, an historic ferryman's track, and glacial terraces, plus lookout points and remnants of Snowdon coal mines. Ideal for hikers and nature lovers, this easy-to-intermediate track combines geology, history, and breathtaking scenery, making it one of Mid-Canterbury's most popular outdoor experiences.




Little River Rail Trail
